7. When spending time in Paris, enjoy the gardens. Local Host Stephane calls Paris' gardens "temples of beauty and perfume." He suggests a walk through Tuileries Garden – a public garden located between the Louvre Museum and the Place de la Concorde.

Stephane commented further to say the iconic tower, "inspires us to dance, jump and photograph ourselves and to commemorate our time in this beautiful city."
