4. For a casual weekend breakfast – full of people watching – go to Borough Market.
5. After a hard morning of window-shopping on glamorous Sloane Street, where the ritzy neighborhoods of Chelsea, Knightsbridge and Belgravia meet, give yourself a treat straight out of Masterpiece Theater with the “champagne afternoon tea” in the Cadogan Hotel. This place became world-famous in 1895 when Oscar Wilde was arrested here for “committing acts of gross indecency.”

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6. An entertaining night-out in London is a tour that follows Jack the Ripper. It provides fascinating insight into the seedy underbelly of Victorian London.
7. Walking the streets of London is the best way to see and grasp the city. You can walk from Buckingham Palace to Westminster in 10 minutes or Covent Garden to Regent Street (shopping central) in 20 minutes. It's a very walk-able place with architecture that spans several centuries: From Medieval and Edwardian to modern.
